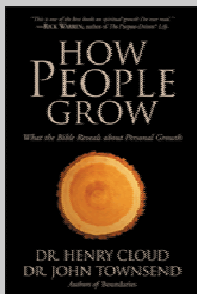


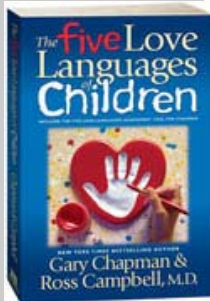
## Topical Books

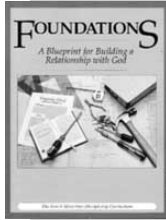

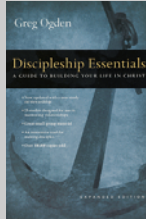

# Beginning Discipleship Resources

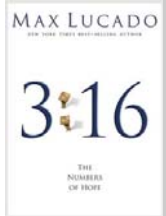


1. Foundations; A Blueprint for Building a Relationship with God, Search Ministries. A beginner study for learning and applying the basics of faith in Christ. It is also an exploratory resource for those who are currently investigating the claims of Christ.

2. Discipleship Essentials; A Guide to Building Your Life in Christ, Greg Ogden. This 24 chapter book covers Christian essentials including growing, understanding, becoming like Christ, and serving Christ.



3. John 3:16, Max Lucado. A beginner study on exploring the scripture John 3:16 to discover that real life can only be found in a faith relationship with Jesus Christ and to commit to living within that relationship.

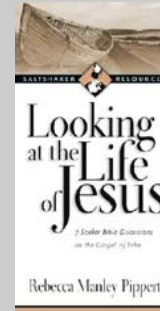


4. One to One Discipling, Multiplication Ministries. Great basics of the Christian faith study. Topics studied are assurance of salvation, attributes of God, the Bible, prayer, the Spirit-filled life, fellowship, witnessing, temptation and obedience.



5. Design for Discipleship, NavPress. A seven part series of basic foundational studies for new believers. It explains what it means to be a Christ-centered disciple, how to develop Christian character, how to have victory over sin, and how to grow toward maturity in your daily walk with God.

6. Looking at the Life of Jesus, Spirituality According to Jesus, or People Who Met Jesus, Rebecca Pippert. Great discussion starters with a bent towards pre-believers.



## What is Discipleship?

Discipleship is a relationship where you intentionally walk alongside a growing disciple or disciples in order to encourage, correct and challenge them in love to grow toward maturity in Christ. You need to be just one step ahead of someone to disciple them. Both of you will learn and grow in your faith through this relationship. The resources listed in this pamphlet are suggested guides to start discussions with flexible formats based on time commitment and learning style. Beginning Discipleship Resources tend to focus on Christian foundations and have less homework than Advanced Discipleship Resources.

7. Alpha: Questions of Life, Nicky Gumbel. Alpha is an opportunity to explore the meaning of life. No question about life or God is seen as too simple or too hostile... questions like - Is there a God? Why am I here? Where did I come from? Where am I going?

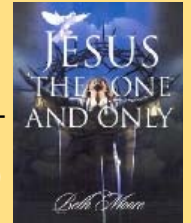


# Advanced Discipleship Resources

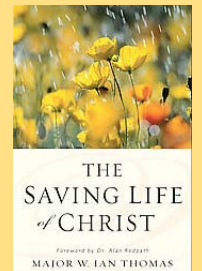


1. Experiencing God, Henry T. Blackaby and Claude V. King. An advanced beginner study to understand and apply biblical principles to a Christian's everyday life.

2. Jesus the One and Only, Beth Moore. An advanced beginner study using truths of scripture to see a close-up and intimate portrait of the life of Jesus the Messiah.



3. Saving Life of Christ, Major W. Ian Thomas. A book for the Christian on leading a victorious spiritual life.



4. The Grace Life Handbook, Grace Ministries International. A study for believers who want to go deeper in their relationship with Christ by studying their identity in Christ. It is a powerful study for believers of all maturities. Each of the 12 lessons has some reading/teaching and a Bible study part.
